Water Management Policy

As part of the ‘Sustainable Vision 2030’ strategy, Mango is committed to managing water responsibly, recognising its importance as a finite and essential resource for textile production.

We are aware of the crucial importance of water for life and almost all human activities, as well as of its fragility and scarcity, especially under conditions that meet the needs of people and ecosystems worldwide.

We therefore consider it crucial to ensure the sustainable use of water, as well as eliminating the discharge of hazardous chemicals, in both our direct and indirect activities.

Key Commitments

- Reduce the water footprint of our products: Reduce water consumption, guarantee wastewater treatment and promote water reuse throughout our value chain.
- Optimise water consumption in our direct operations:

Improve the efficiency of water use at our headquarters, logistics centres, production centres and stores.

- Improve water management in our supply chain: Reduce water consumption in our suppliers’ production operations and ensure adequate treatment of the wastewater generated.
- Transparency and compliance: Maintain transparency in our water and chemical management monitoring indicators.
- Discharge control and management of chemical substances: Collaborate with suppliers to implement a chemical management system, ensuring the control of hazardous substance spills and compliance with current regulations.

Targets for 2030

Mango is committed to reducing its water impact by 25% by 2030, with a base year of 2024, by focusing on:

- Efficient water use: Optimise water use at all stages of the supply chain, including material production and wastewater treatment.
- Chemical and wastewater management: Ensure proper management of wastewater and chemicals in our production processes.

Tools and Monitoring

To measure and verify the impact of these actions, Mango will use indicators aligned with water footprint measurement frameworks (CEO Water Mandate, Alliance for Water Stewardship, TNFD, CSRD, among others).

In chemical management, Mango aligns itself with the Zero Discharge Hazardous Chemicals initiative and its list of restricted substances. Mango will work together with its suppliers to ensure that the targets established are met.
